LAKEVIEW DECEMBER 2015 CRIME REPORT

NOVEMBER 2015 UCR SUMMARY

In November 2015, there were three (3) documented uniformed crimes reported in the Lakeview area (See Table Below).

NOVEMBER UNIT STATISTICS: 959 complaints, 326 residence checks, 681 business checks, 132 traffic stops, 84 verbal traffic warnings, 132 traffic tickets, and 130 field interviews were conducted. Proactive investigations resulted in 13 arrests for the month.

DECEMBER 2015 UCR SUMMARY

In DECEMBER 2015, thirteen (13) property crimes were reported compared to twenty-one (21) in December 2014.

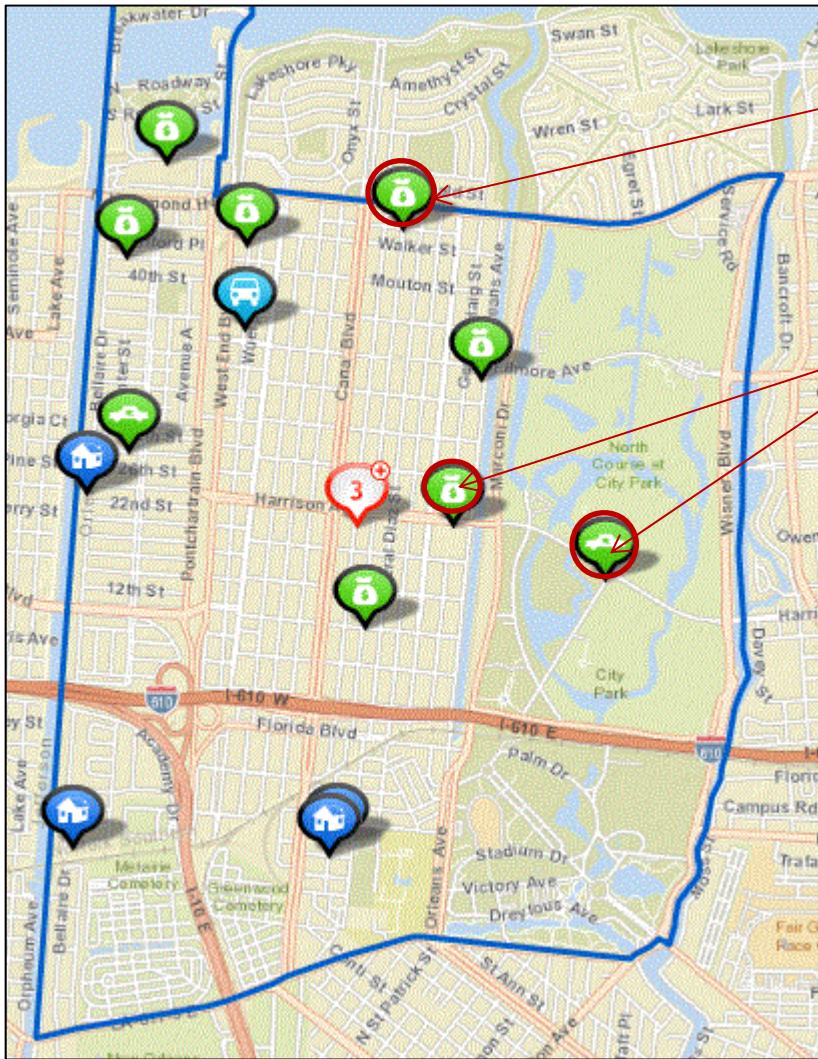

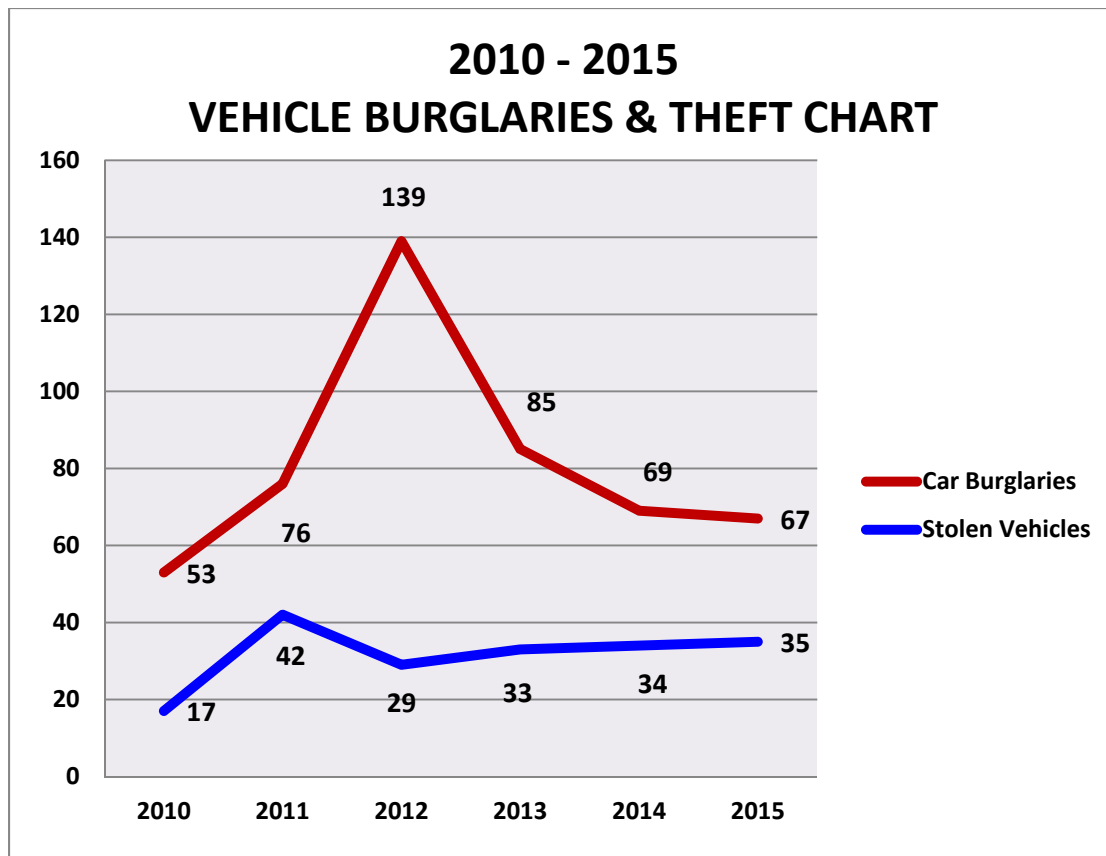

2010 – 2015 VEHICLE BURGLARY & VEHICLE THEFT STATISTICS:

Property crimes involving vehicles have always been a significant concern in Lakeview due to unsecured vehicles, to be specific, unlocked vehicle doors.

Larceny crimes involving vehicles have declined since 2012; however, a constant variable still exist; in **88%** of cases, vehicles were unlocked when crime occurred.

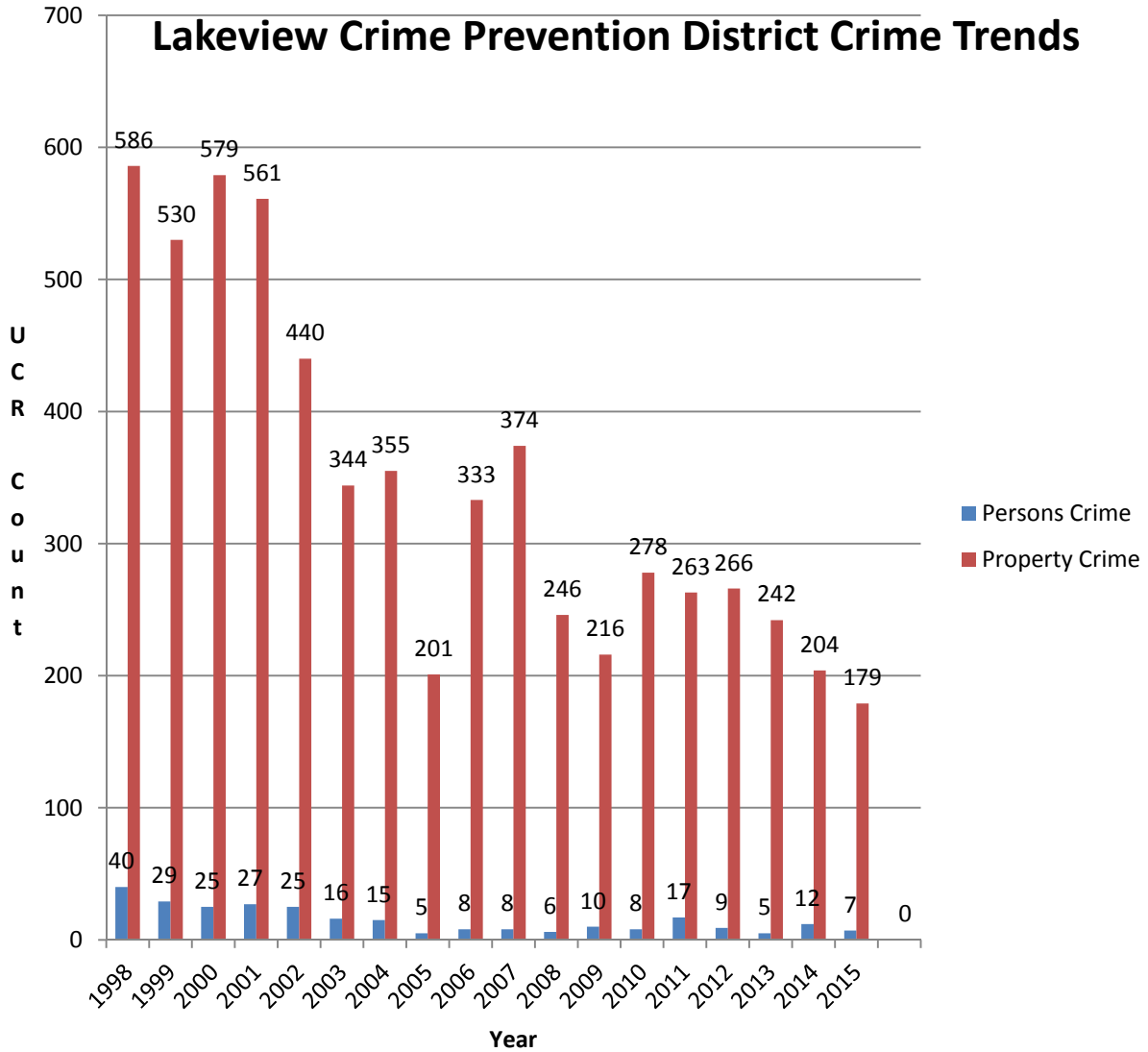

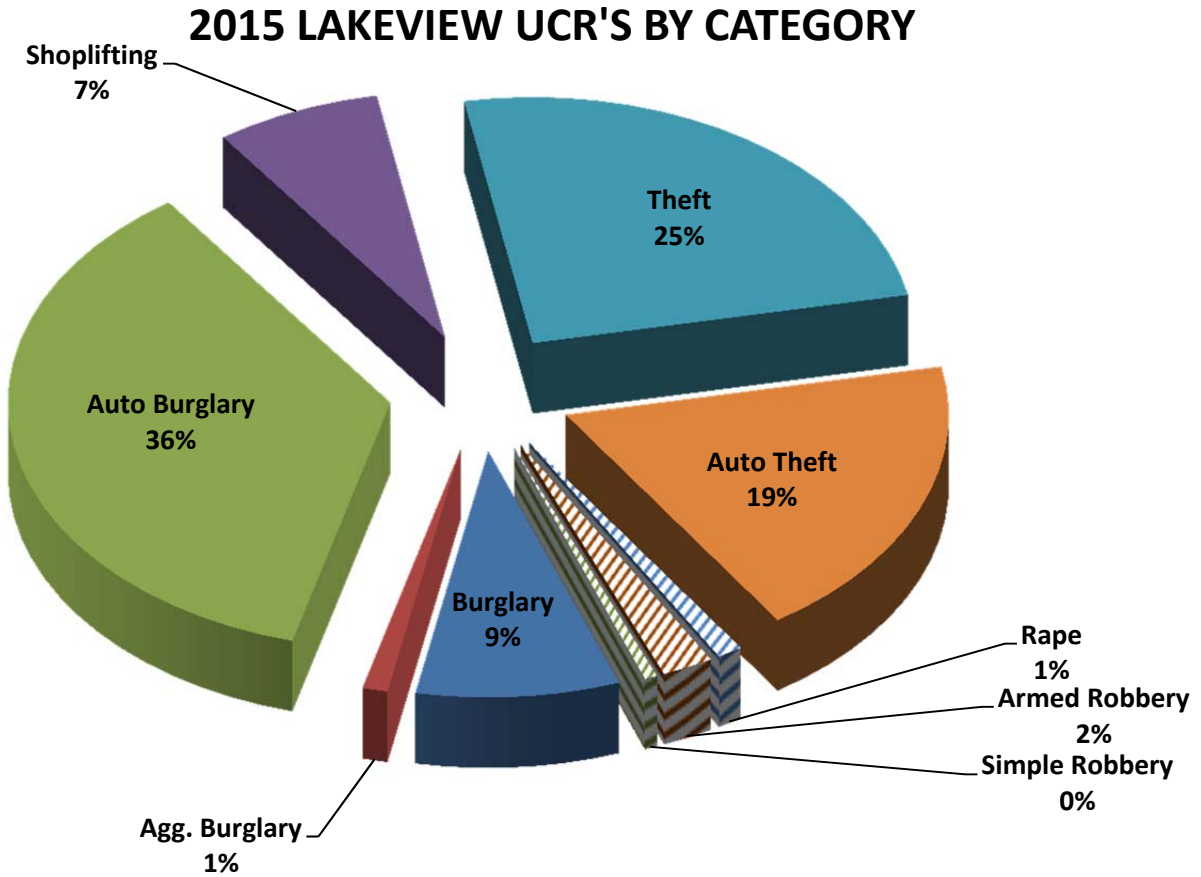

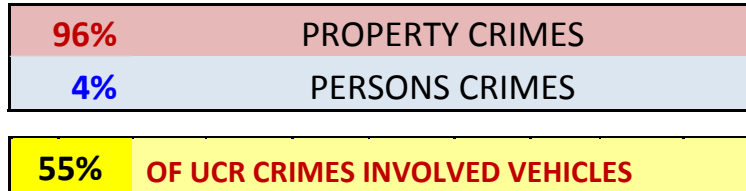

COMMANDER'S COMMENTARY:

The New Orleans Police Officers who patrol the Lakeview Crime Prevention District are an ambitious group of team oriented men and women dedicated to keeping the community safe. Through their efforts and hard work, crime in Lakeview is down **14%** in 2015, following a **12.5%** decrease in 2014. That's an overall **26.5%** reduction in crime over the past two year period.

One hundred and eighty six (186) uniform crimes were documented in 2015. The lowest crime rate recorded in Lakeview since LCPD was implemented in 1998. During 2015, there has not been a single complaint made against a Lakeview Officer concerning professionalism or any other department violation which speaks to the quality of service these officers provide.

As a unit, LCPD's goal is simple to eliminate crime in Lakeview through community policing, highly visible proactive patrols, crime analysis, strategic deployment of resources, and by assisting the 3rd District with conducting thorough investigations.

In 2016, the LCPD Unit will be held to an even higher standard in the interest of public safety. The officers who patrol Lakeview on an overtime basis pledge to perform their duties with a high level of proficiency and community service. The LCPD pool of officers is constantly growing as new officers are eager to become part of the Lakeview Crime Prevention District team.
