Brian stated the committee's goals: 1. Select a server or service that will provide crime camera surveillance in Lakeview. 2. Select a remote location and install equipment that will monitor the cameras.

Brian described Lake Vista cameras that are mounted on light poles with no Internet connection and no live images. Images are manually downloaded.

Brian mentioned the existing Project NOLA program that offers a crime camera on loan to residents for a \$100 security deposit and \$10 monthly service fee.

Reid made a motion to create a Request for Quote for a network crime camera service according to the requirements that the committee will write up at a later date. Val seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

Wally made a motion that Ralph Schindler - technical advisor will formulate a list of hardware and software required by the service contractor for accomplishing the crime camera monitoring station. Reid seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

Reid made a motion that discussion of the monitoring station is tabled for a future meeting. Val seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

Bryan Lagarde gave a short presentation of Project NOLA, a non-profit camera system that connects 1,700 crime cameras in New Orleans.

Brian scheduled the next meeting for Dec. 3 at 6:00 p.m. in Saint Dominic Rectory.

Wally made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Reid seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.
