**SEPTEMBER 2015 UCR SUMMARY**

In September 2015, there were twenty (20) documented uniformed crimes that occurred in the Lakeview area (See Table Below).

**SEPTEMBER UNIT STATISTICS:** 1268 complaints, 286 residence checks, 486 business checks, 180 traffic stops, 144 verbal traffic warnings, 77 traffic tickets, and 166 field interviews were conducted. Proactive investigations resulted in 34 arrests for the month.

**OCTOBER 2015 UCR SUMMARY**

In OCTOBER 2015, fourteen (14) property crimes were reported going against nineteen (19) in October 2014.

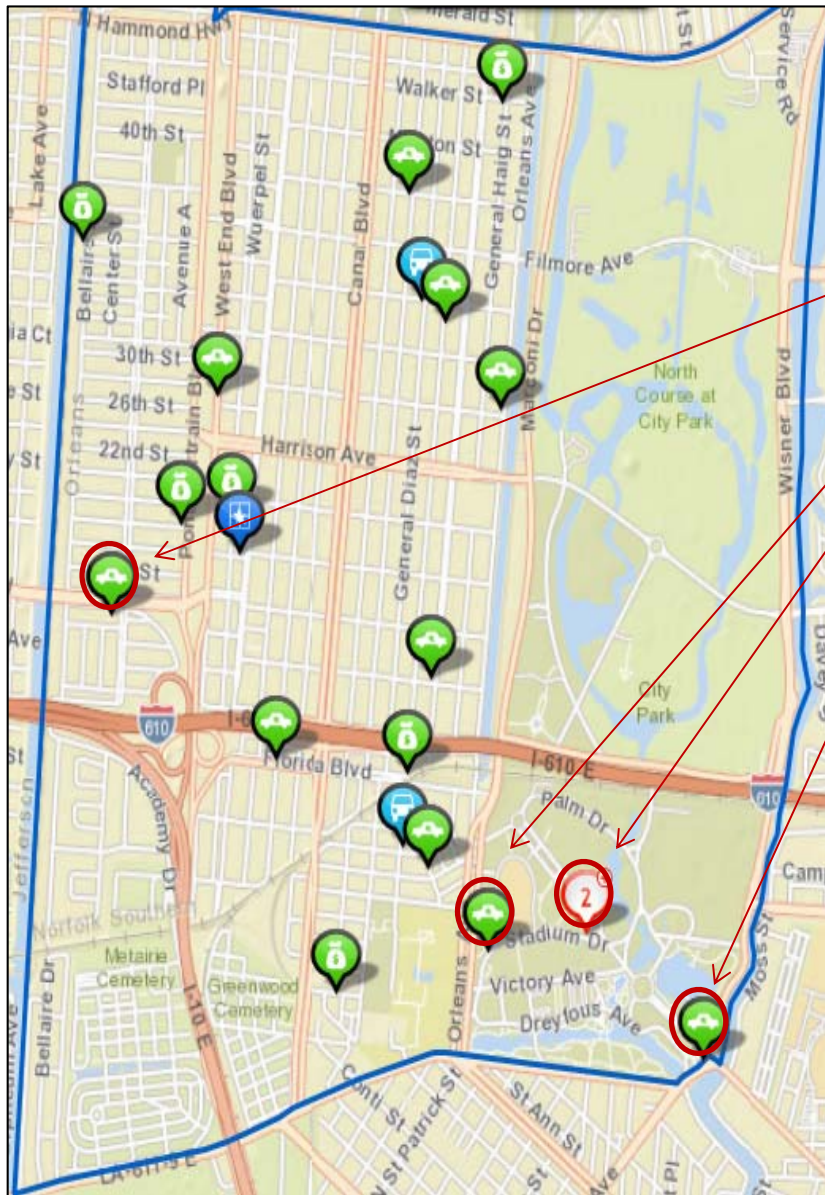

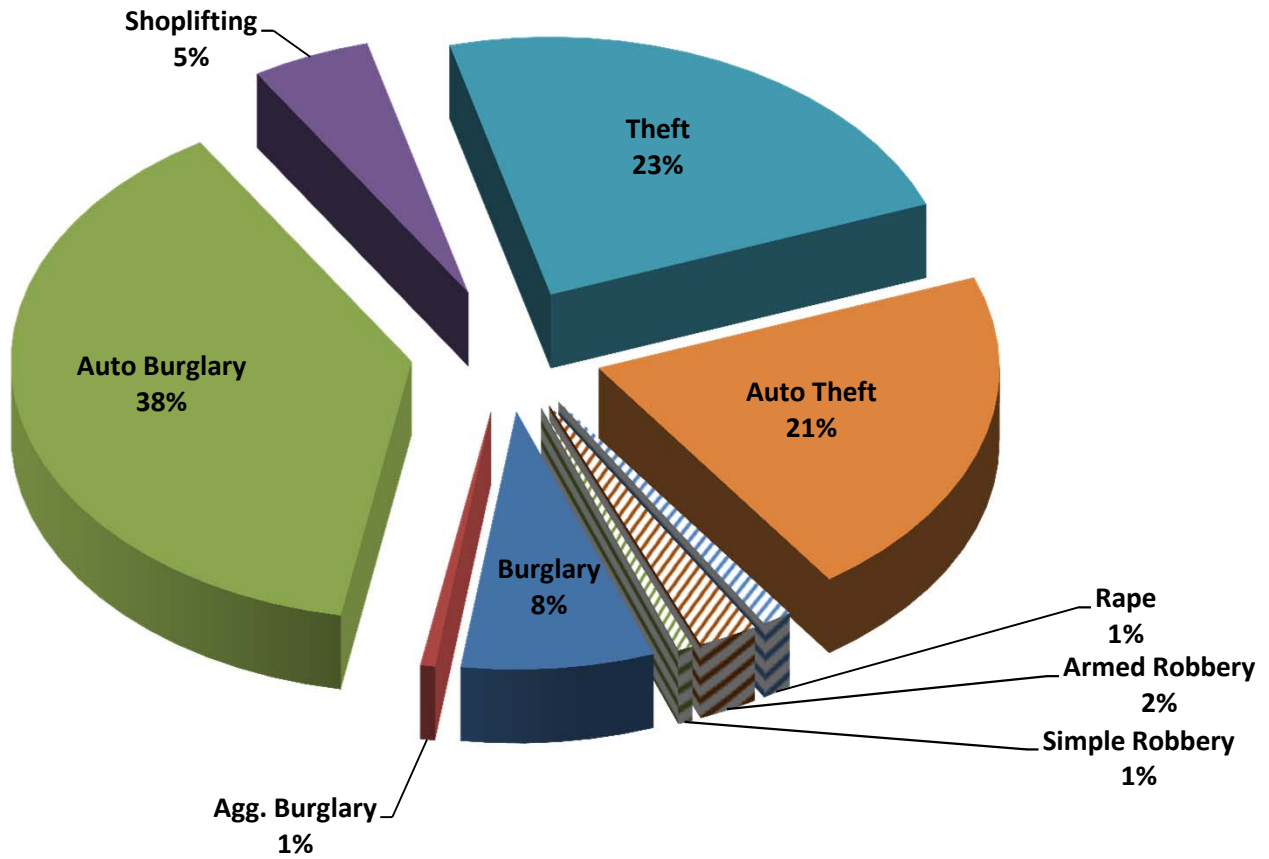

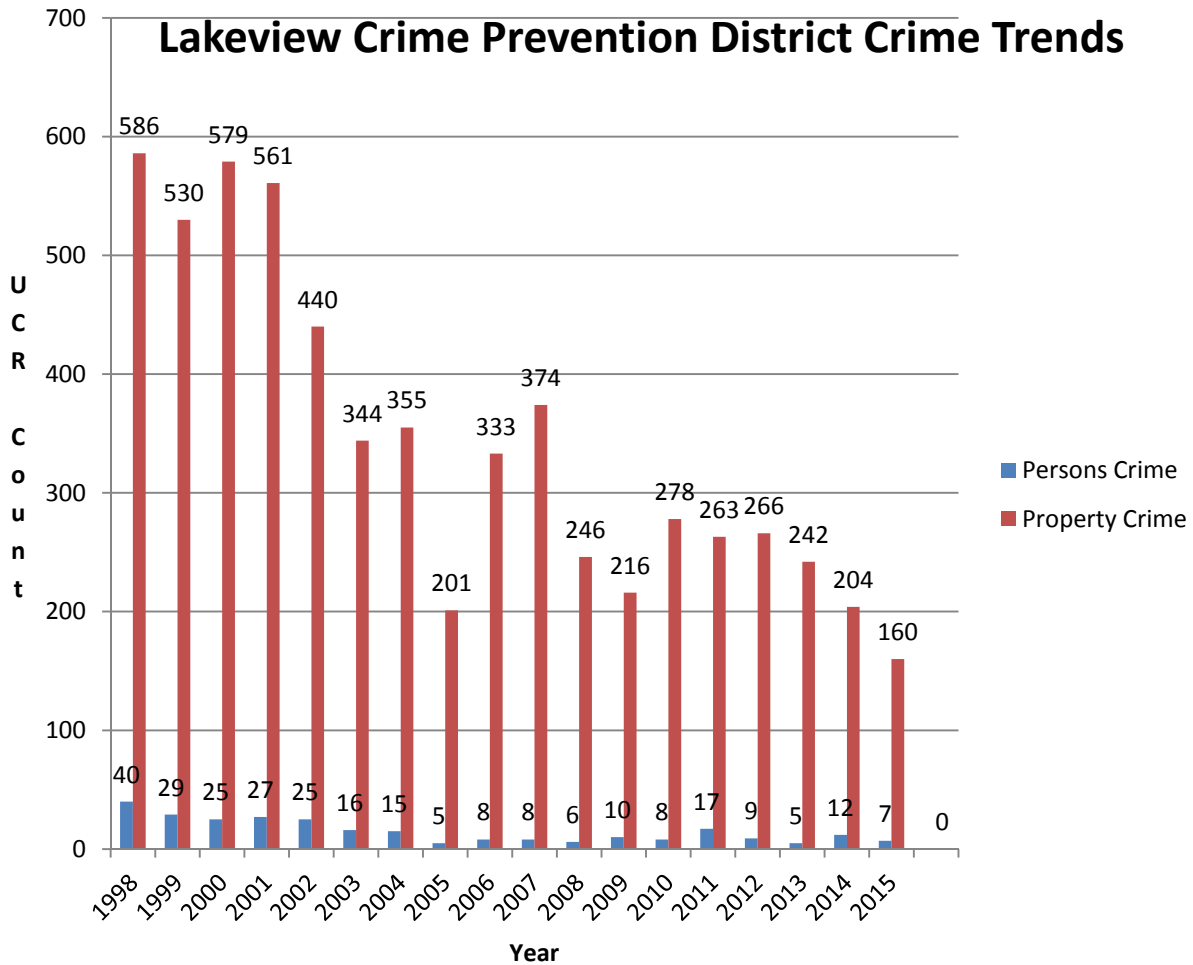

LAKEVIEW CRIME TREND:



PERSON’S CRIMES, “Crimes committed against human beings”, have declined

- Year to date there are seven (7) Lakeview Person’s Crimes on record compared to twelve (12) in 2014; **-58% reduction.**
- Four (4) Armed Robberies; 3 cases cleared by arrest; **75% clearance.**
- One (1) Simple Robbery; Case cleared by arrest; **100% clearance.**
- Two (2) Sexual Assaults; One (1) cleared by arrest and the other case is still under investigation.

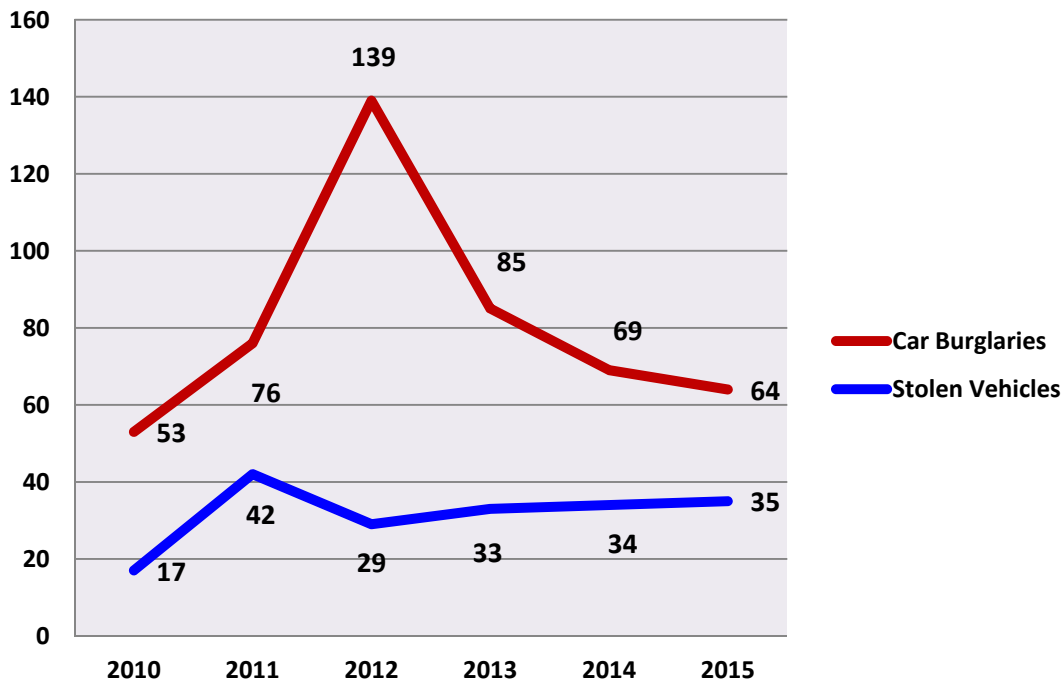
**2010 – 2015 VEHICLE BURGLARY & VEHICLE THEFT STATISTICS:**

Property crimes involving vehicles have always been a significant concern in Lakeview due to unsecured vehicles, to be specific, unlocked vehicle doors

Larceny crimes involving vehicles have declined since 2012; however, a constant variable still exists; in 84% of cases, the vehicles were unlocked when crime occurred.

**FOLLOWUP:** On 9/29/15 at 3:10pm, the perpetrator was arrested on a job site in Lakeview without incident and was subsequently charged with Simple Burglary of An Inhabited Dwelling and Possession of Stolen Property.
