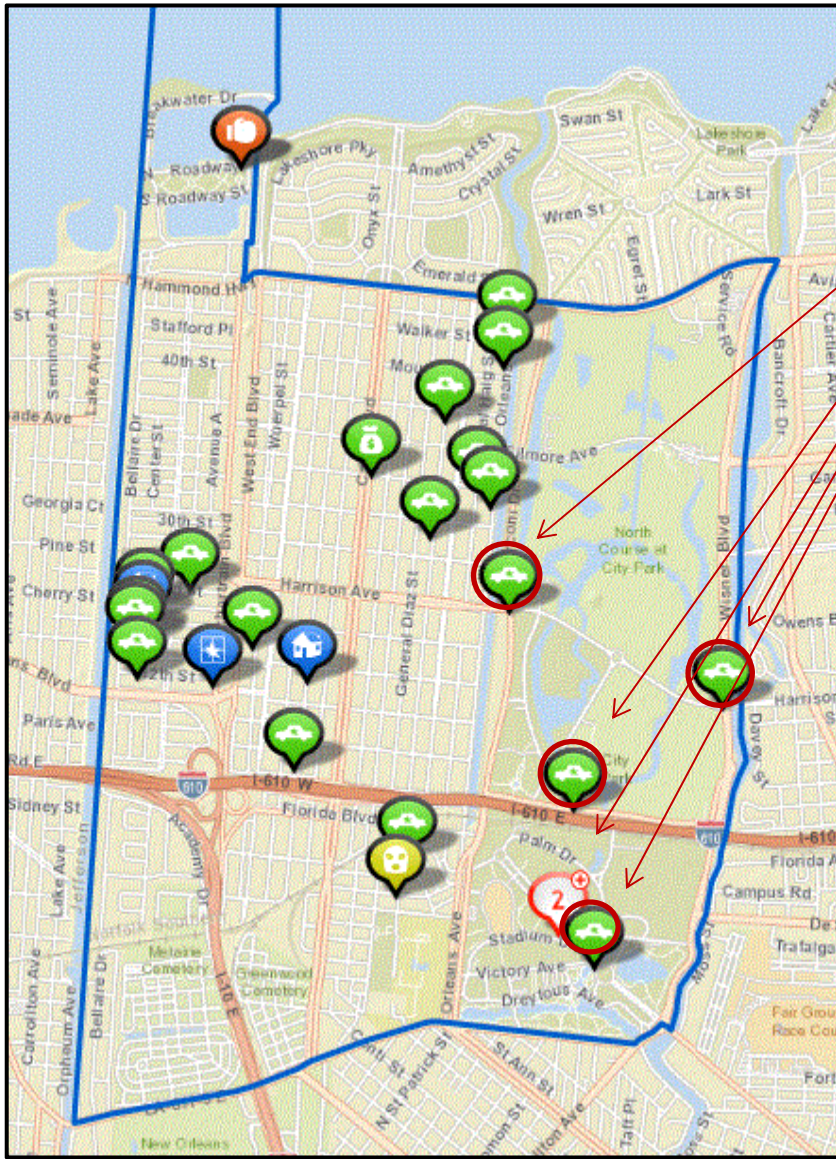

INCIDENT GIST

In JANUARY 2016, twenty (20) UCR crimes were reported Lakeview

- **02 Person's Crimes.**

- (1) Armed Robbery – Occurred 01/02/2016 (800 Blk of Hildago)
 - Grateful the victim was not harmed
 - Vehicle and cell phone taken during the robbery
 - Vehicle recovered in Jefferson Parish on 01/04/16
 - 3rd District Detective Matthew Morrison is the lead investigator on the case.
- (1) Aggravated Battery by Cutting – Occurred 01/20/16 (100 Blk N. Roadway)
 - Physical encounter between two friends resulted in both individuals being stabbed multiple times.
 - Perpetrator apprehended on scene by Lakeview Officers.
 - Both individuals transported to the hospital; victim was listed in critical condition and perpetrator in serious but stable condition.

- (2) Residence Burglaries
 - Forced entry used in one incident; Nothing Taken
 - No Forced Entry in the other
 - Jewelry and Flat Screen TV's taken.
- (1) Attempted Residence Burglary

- On Sunday, January 02, 2016 at 10:40 pm victim was robbed by three assailants near the intersection of Marshall Foch & Hildago St. Victim exited his vehicle and walked towards his residence when approached by three (3) unknown subjects on foot who asked to use victim's cell phone to call their mother. One subject, with hand in jacket pocket implying he had a weapon, pointed an unknown object to victim's head through the jacket pocket, and stated, "Get the Money, get the keys, and don't move". Subject #3 then took possession of victim's iPhone 6 and keys to victim's silver 2004 Saturn and drove off headed down Marshall Foch St. The other two perpetrators fled on foot Westbound on Hildago St. then unknown.

- Perpetrator Descriptions:
 - **Perpetrator #1** – Black female, 5' 7", 110-120 lbs, 16-18 years of age, varsity jacket with red hoodie and blue jeans.
 - **Perpetrator #2** – Black male, 6' 1", 190-210 lbs, glasses, 20-21 years of age, dark hoodie, camouflage pattern joggers.
 - **Perpetrator #3** – Black male, 5'9" – 5'11", 135 lbs, 17-19 years of age, old chee-wee hair style, brone animal mask, dark hoodie with logo, and dark joggers.

- Vehicle recovered on 01/04/16 in Jefferson Parish
- Evidence recovered from vehicle and investigation ongoing.

- Unlocked vehicle searched; Pink purse containing a Sam's Club card and other various membership cards stolen.

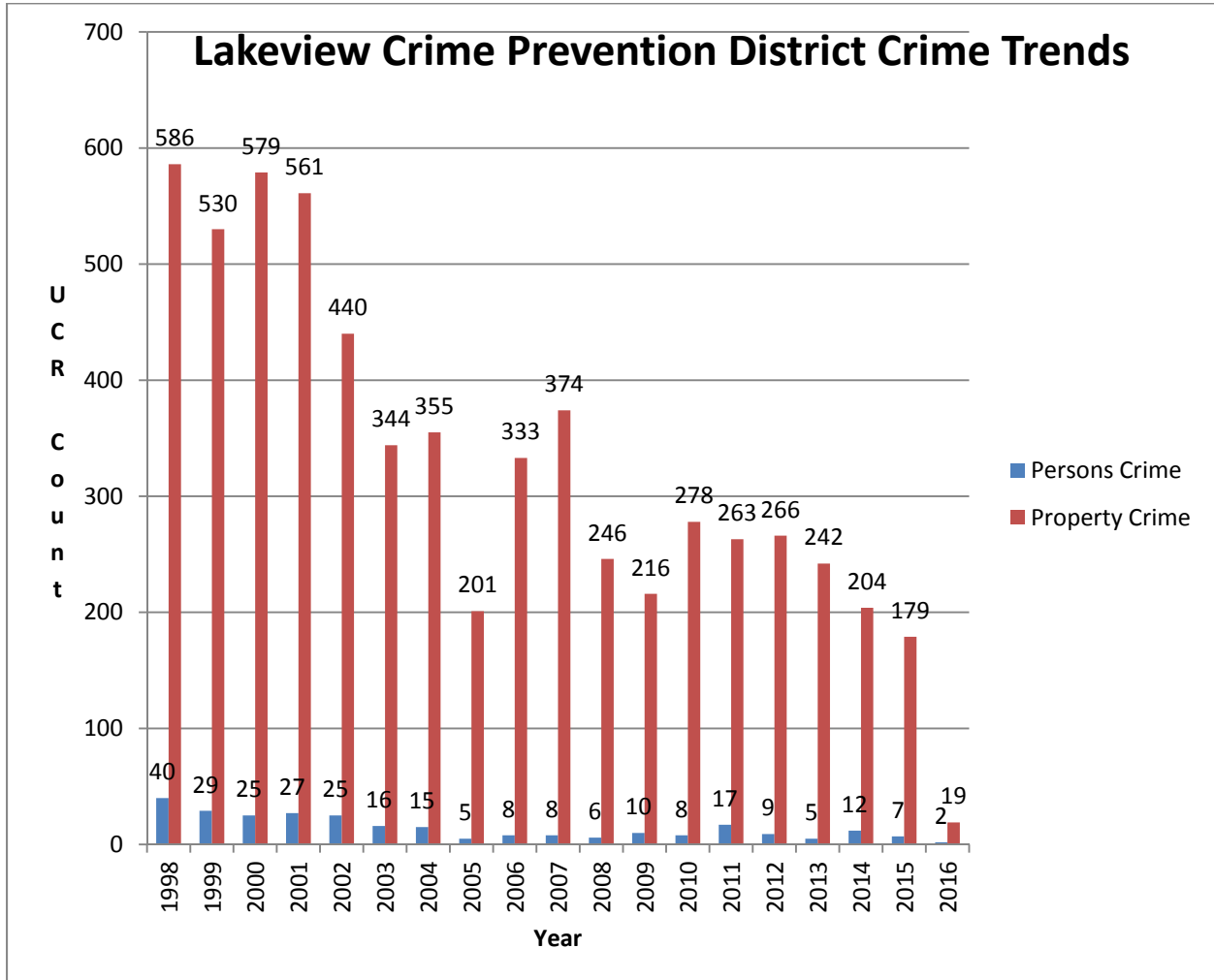
ATTEMPT SIMPLE

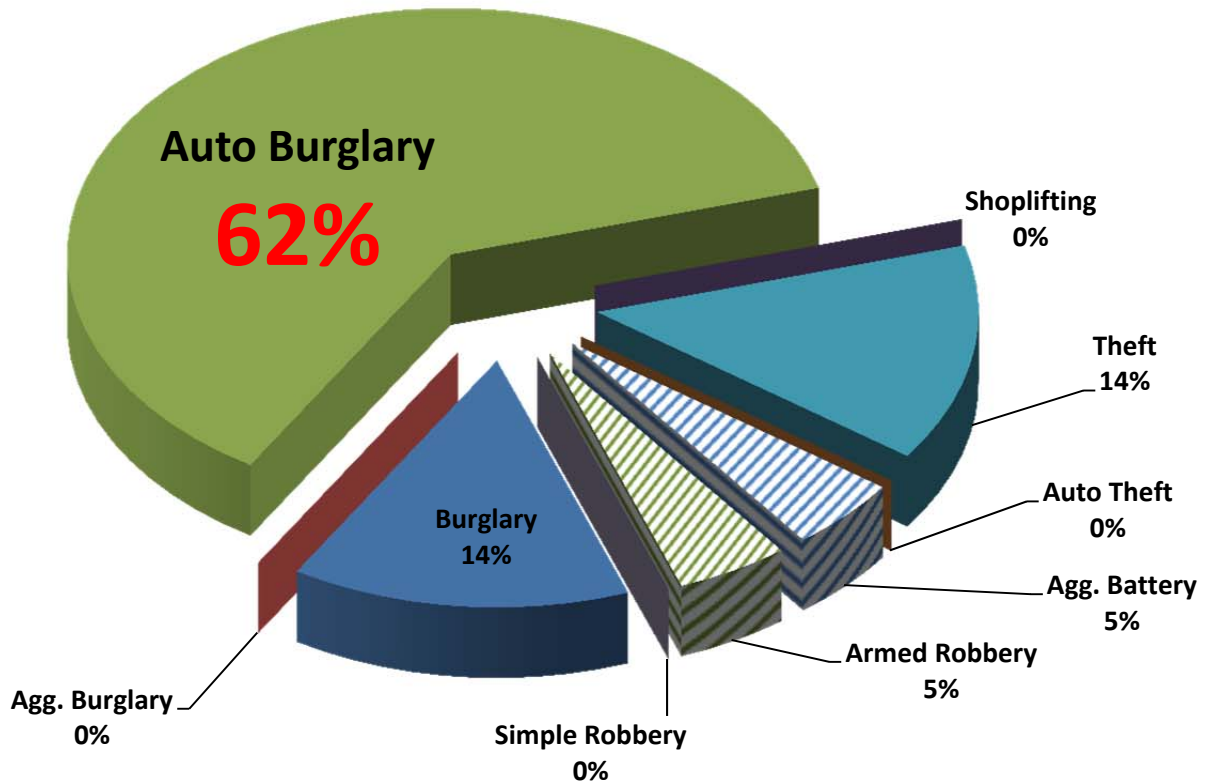

COMMANDER'S COMMENTARY:

The New Orleans Police Officers who patrol Lakeview Crime Prevention District are an ambitious group of team oriented men and women dedicated to keeping your community safe. Through their efforts and hard work, crime in Lakeview is down **14%** in 2015, following a **12.5%** decrease in 2014, resulting in an overall **26.5%** decrease in a two year period. One hundred and eighty six (186) uniform crimes were documented in 2015 which is the lowest crime rate in Lakeview since LCPD was created in 1998. Also during 2015, there has not been a single complaint made against a Lakeview Officer concerning professionalism or any other department violation which speaks to the quality of service these officers provide.

As a unit, LCPD's goal is simple to eliminate crime in Lakeview through community policing, highly visible proactive patrols, crime analysis, strategic deployment of resources, and by assisting the 3rd District with conducting thorough investigations.

In 2016, the LCPD Unit will be held to an even higher standard in the interest of public safety. The officers who patrol Lakeview on an overtime basis vow to provide a more improved and efficient level of service. Our pool of resources is constantly growing as officers are eager to become part of the LCPD team.

LCPD Officers are committed to reducing crime in Lakeview and look forward to further crime reductions in 2016
