INTRODUCTION

WHAT IS A UNIFORM CRIME REPORT?

The FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting Program was implemented in 1930 by the International Association of Chiefs of Police to ensure uniformity among law enforcement agencies when reporting crimes to the Federal Government. Statistics are gathered from participating states on eight index crimes.

UCR CRIME CATEGORIES ARE:

- MURDER
- RAPE
- ROBBERY
- AGGRAVATED ASSAULT
- BURGLARY
- THEFT
- AUTO THEFT
- ARSON

With the exception of murder, attempted crimes are included in crime totals. Attempted murder is counted as an Aggravated Assault.

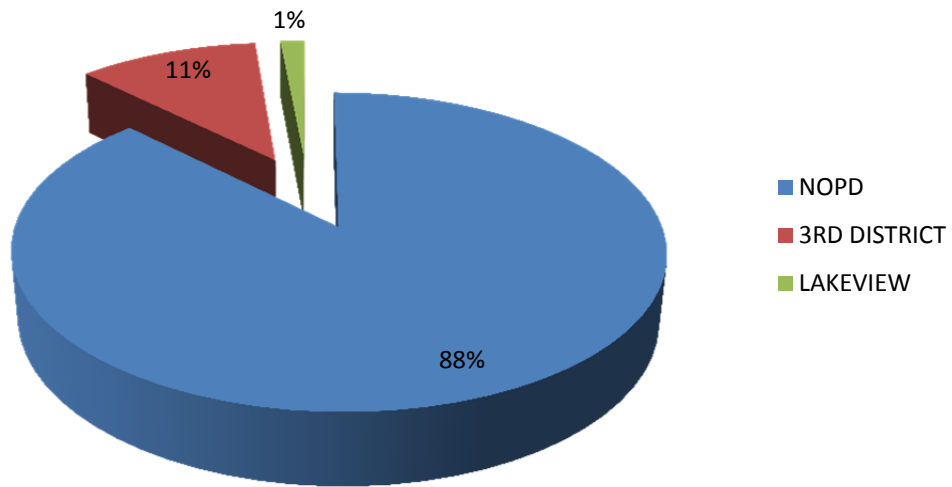

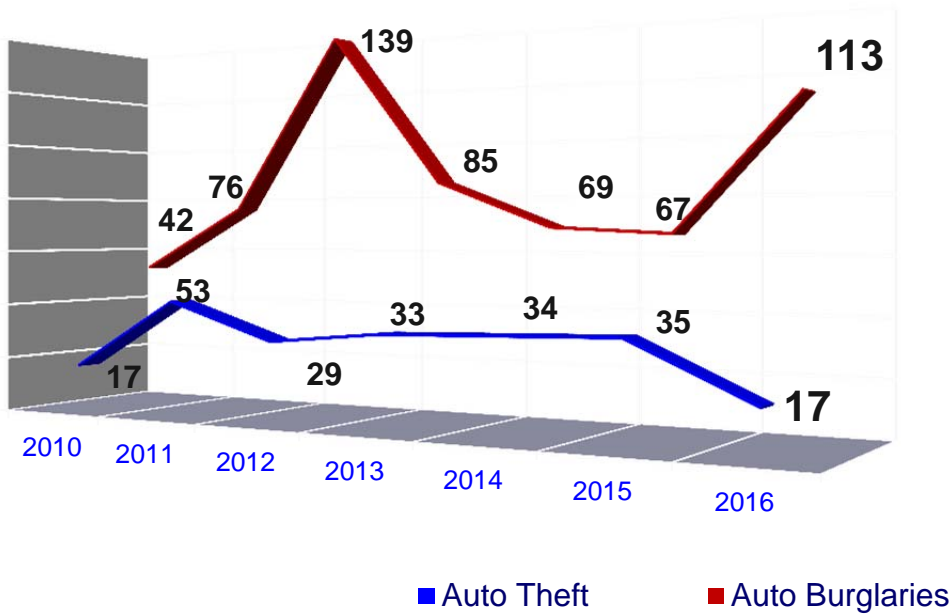

AUTO BURGLARY & AUTO THEFT CHART**



- **113 Auto Burglaries Reported this year**
 - 98 vehicles were UNLOCKED when crime occurred (87%)
 - 33 Cases cleared by arrest or warrant (29% Clearance Rate)
 - In 40 incidents vehicles were searched but nothing was stolen.
 - Year to date, seven (7) guns were stolen from UNSECURED vehicles.
- **17 Auto Thefts Reported YTD**
 - 14 Vehicles were unlocked when stolen
 - 9 stolen with car keys left inside the vehicles.
 - 11 Vehicles recovered and returned to their owners.
 - 2 Cases Cleared by Arrest

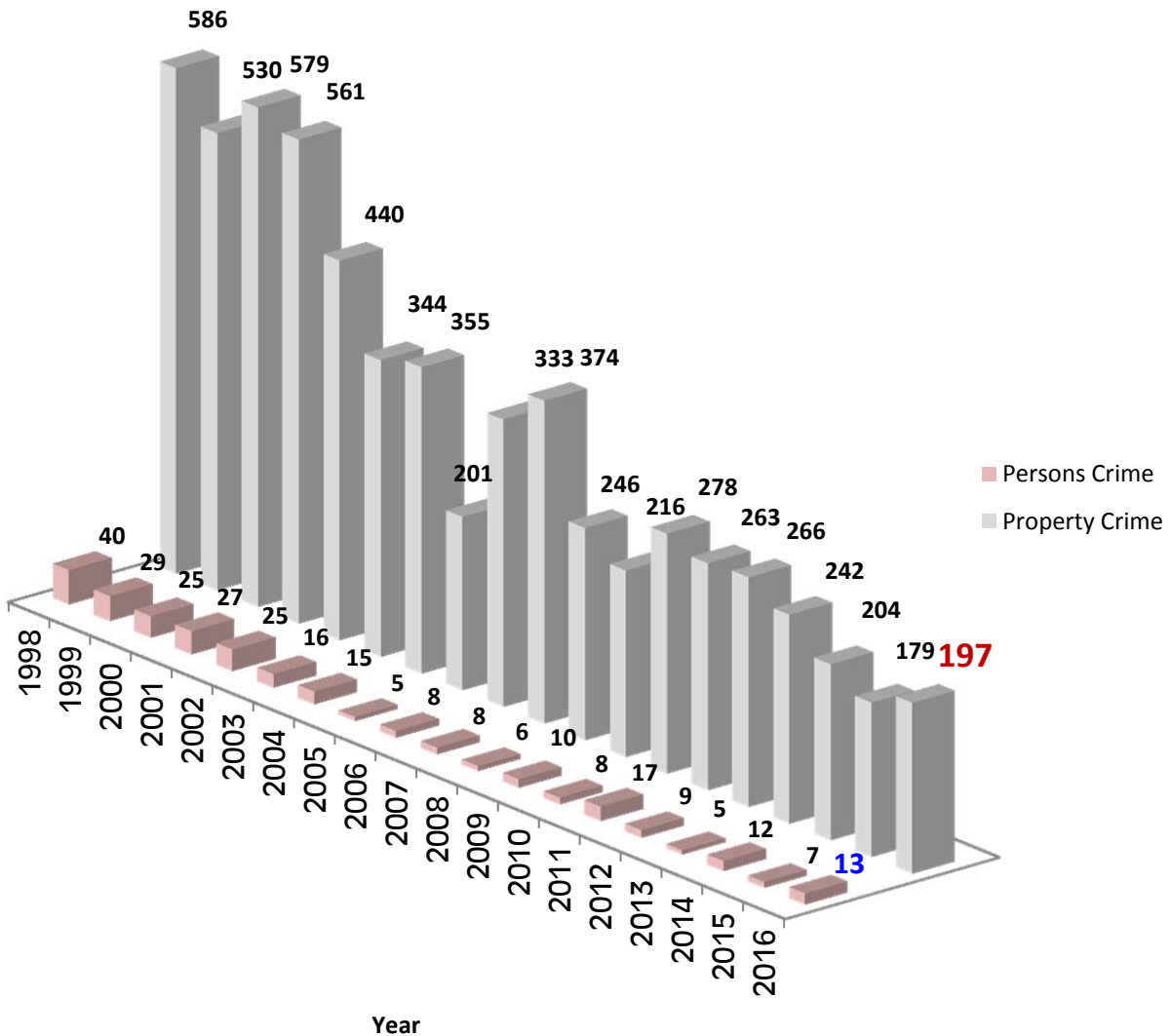

CRIME PREVENTION:

CRIME PREVENTION TIPS:

- Always lock the doors to your homes and vehicles.

- Secure valuables in the trunk or inside your residence once you've reach your destination.

QUALITY OF LIFE ISSUES:

DIAL 311 for QOL matters.

QOL complaints involving City or State Agencies need to be called in to 311. Once the complaint is called in to 311, a work order number is generated and issued to the caller. Complaints are sent out to the respective city agency to be investigated. Citizens can call 311 and give the operator that work order number, to track the progress of the complaint.

Types of QOL complaints which should be called in to 311:

- Oversized Vehicles
- Abandoned Boats
- Abandoned or Illegally Parked Vehicles
- Trash Complaints
- Illegal Dumping
- Wild Animals / Barking Dogs
- Street Signage Complaint
- Blight/ Overgrown Lots
