INTRODUCTION

WHAT IS A UNIFORM CRIME REPORT?

The FBI's Uniform Crime Reporting Program was implemented in 1930 by the International Association of Chiefs of Police to ensure uniformity among law enforcement agencies when reporting crimes to the Federal Government. Statistics are gathered from participating states on eight index crimes.

UCR CRIME CATEGORIES ARE:

- MURDER
- RAPE
- ROBBERY
- AGGRAVATED ASSAULT
- BURGLARY
- THEFT
- AUTO THEFT
- ARSON

With the exception of murder, attempted crimes are included in crime totals. Attempted murder is counted as an Aggravated Assault.

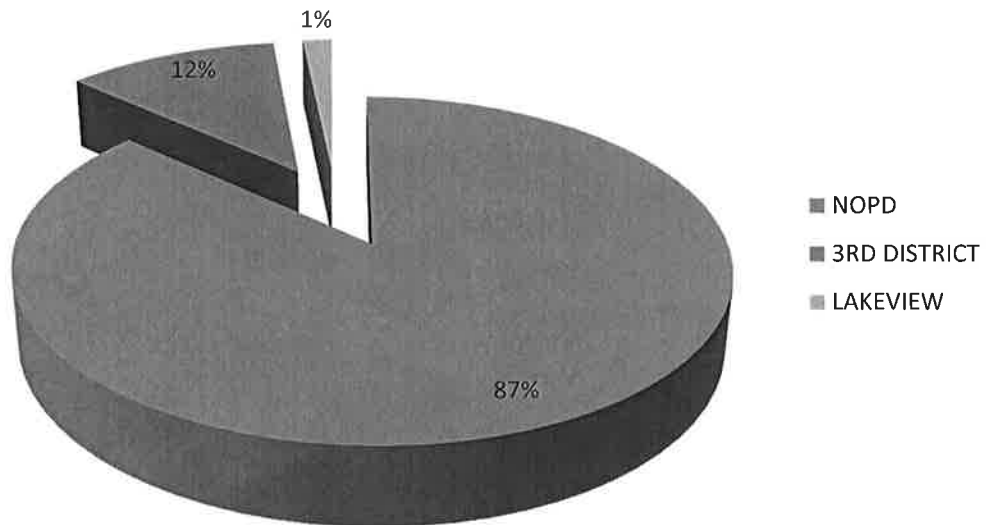

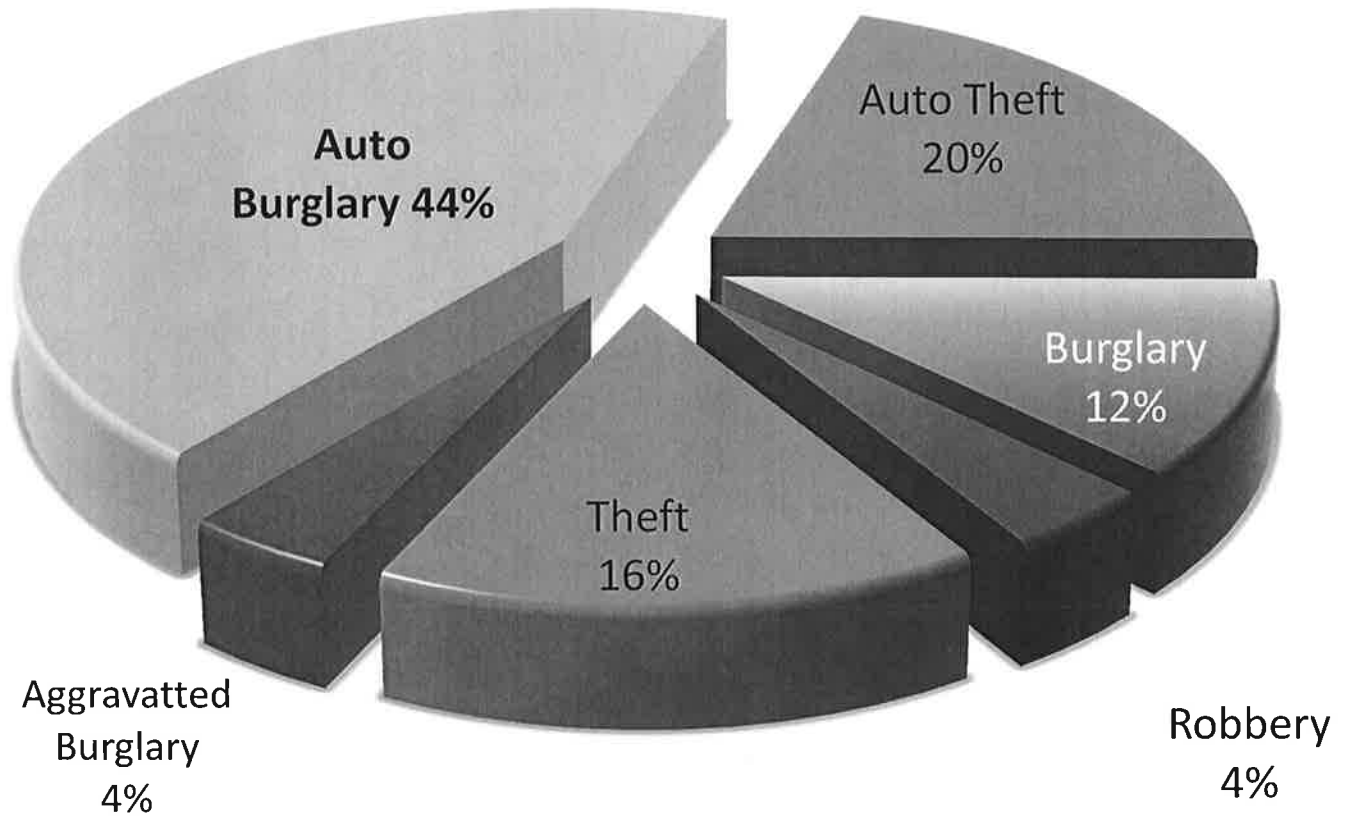

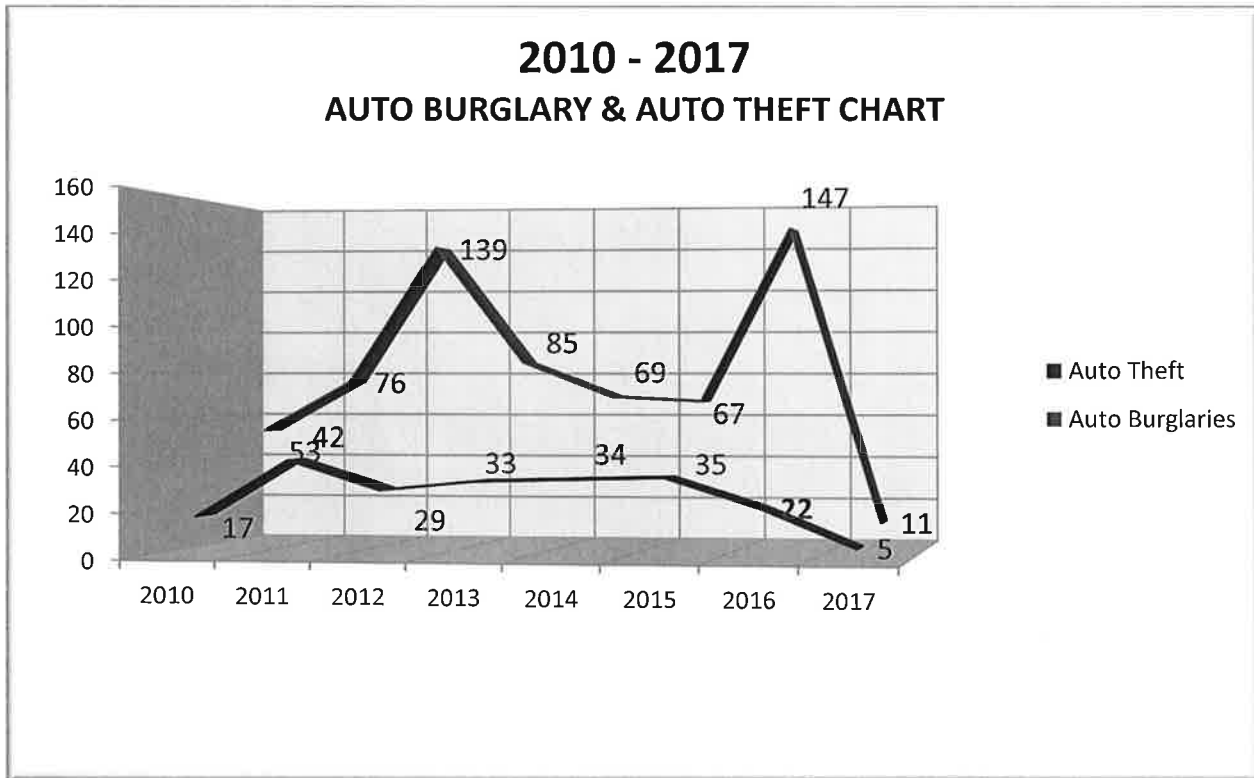

AUTO BURGLARY AND AUTO THEFT:

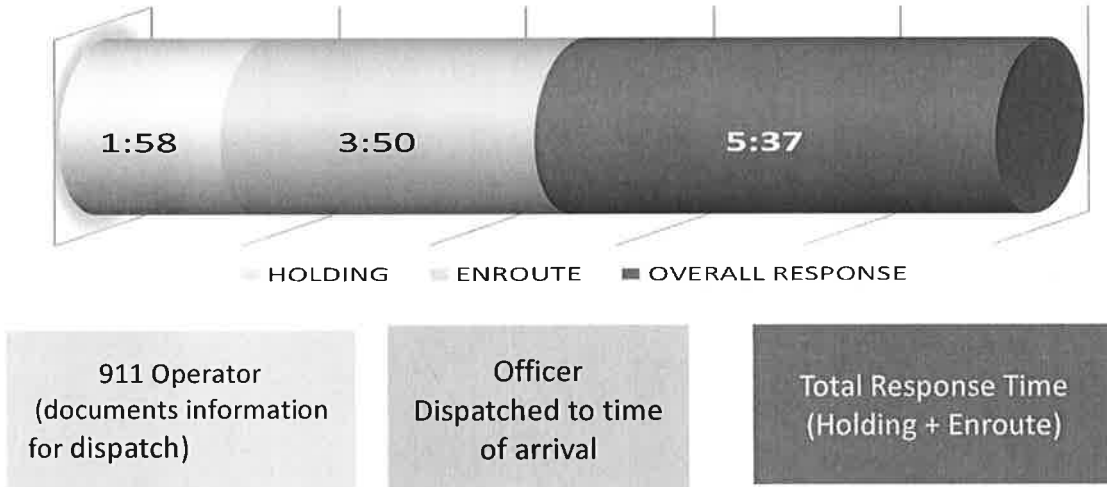


- **11 Auto Burglaries Reported**

- **05 Auto Thefts Reported**
 - Five (5) vehicles stolen with keys.
 - Four (4) vehicles have been recovered and returned to owners.
 - One (1) incident cleared by arrest

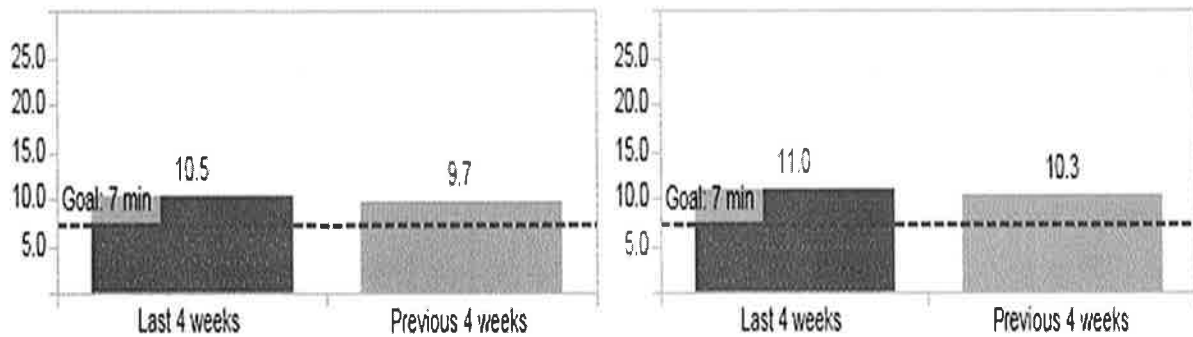

Response time by week for the past 52 weeks

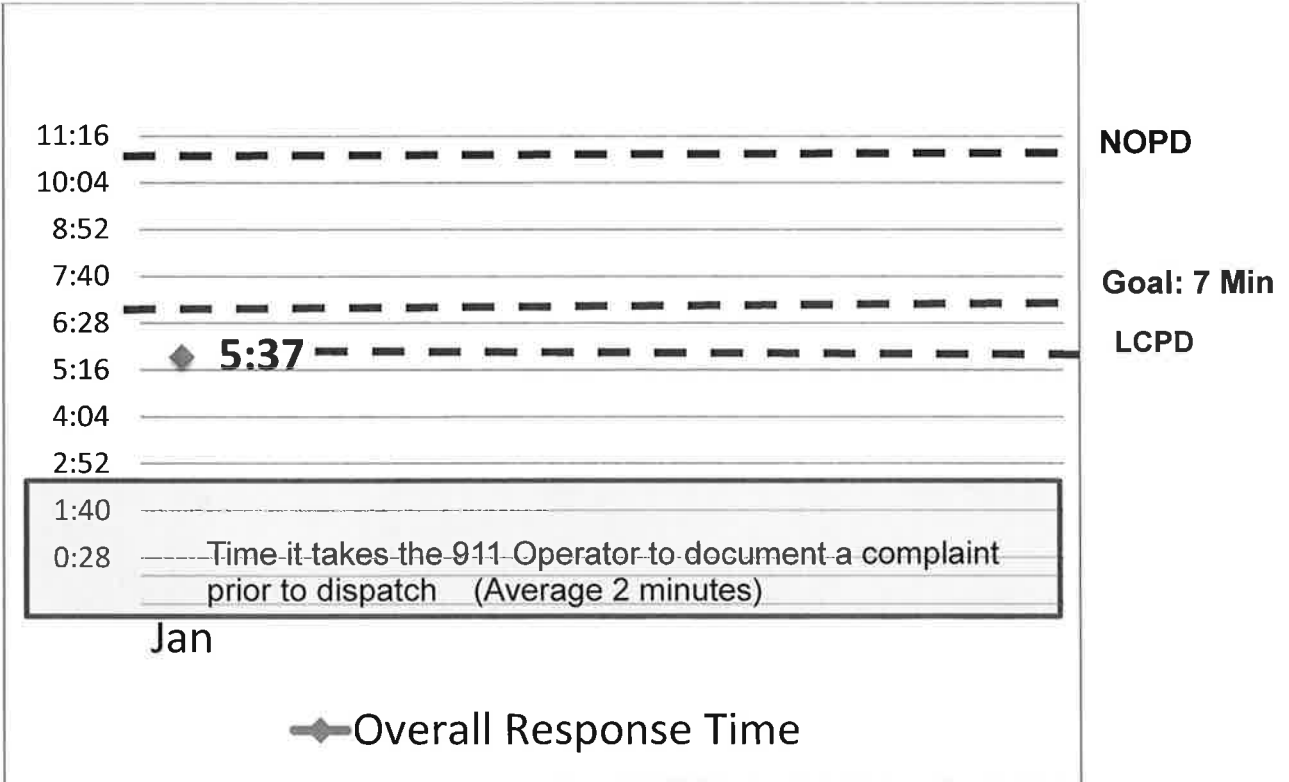

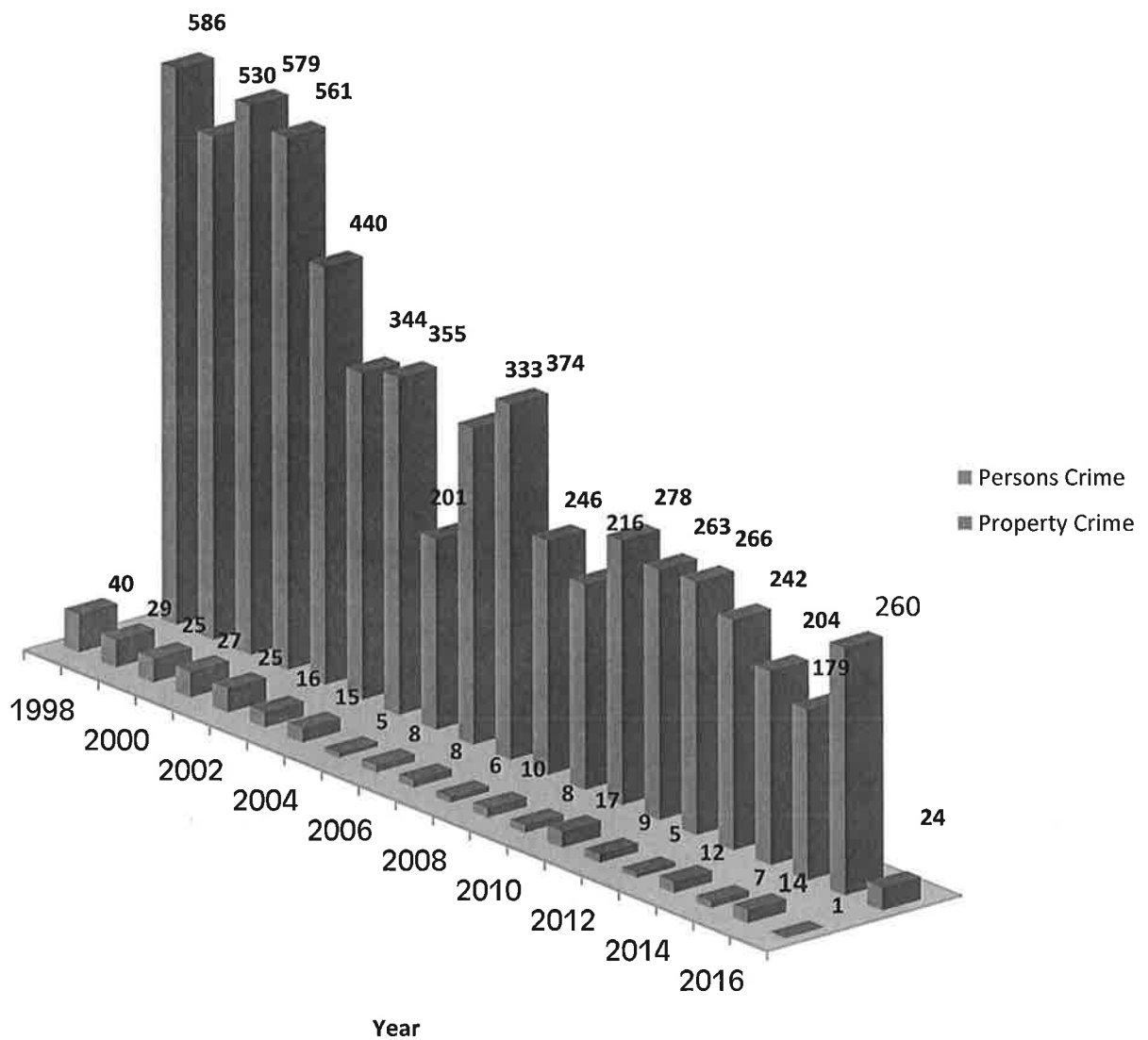

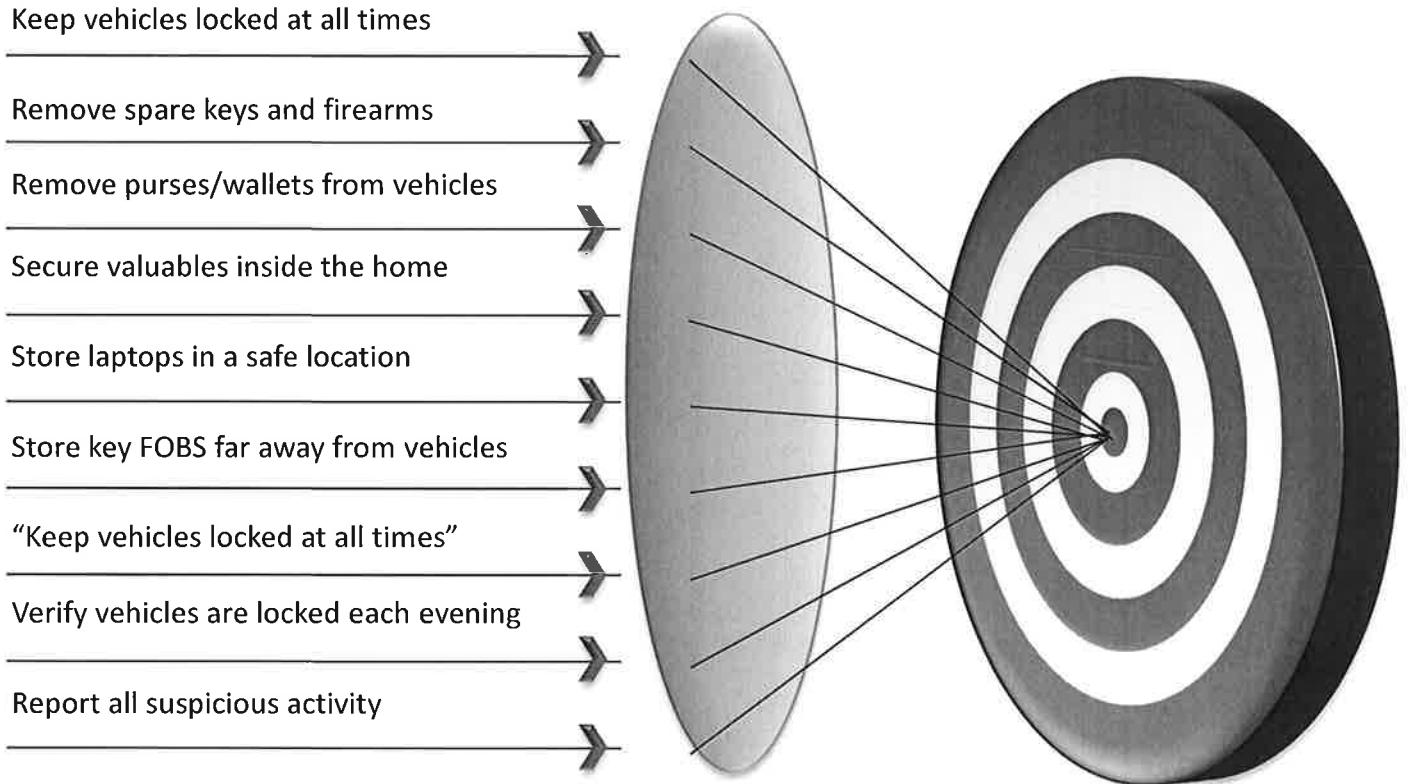

LCPD 2016 REVIEW AND COMMENTARY:

In 2016 the New Orleans Police Department experienced an 11% increase in property crimes and an 8% increase in person's crimes. Law enforcement agencies around the state share the same challenges in fighting crime but one issue that appears to be prevalent yet universal is the epidemic regarding burglaries involving unlocked vehicles. Many criminals take the path of least resistance by choosing to burglarize unlocked and unsecured vehicles.

It is no secret that Lakeview auto burglary incidents spiked in 2016. One hundred and forty seven (147) auto burglaries were reported in 2016, that's 80 more incidents reported than in 2015. In 38% of those cases, no property was stolen; however, once entry is gained, that incident counts as an auto burglary crime statistic.

FACT: An astonishing statistic is that 124 of the 147 auto burglary incidents reported in Lakeview in 2016 involved unlocked vehicles.

FACT: Another unbelievable statistic is that a total of twelve (12) firearms were stolen from vehicles that were unlocked.

FACT: Approximately 82% of all auto burglaries occurred overnight between the hours of midnight and 6:00 a.m.

FACT: Leaving weapons inside vehicles overnight endangers the lives of everyone in the community.

Crimes involving vehicles, either burglarized or stolen, accounted for 63% of the UCR crimes reported in Lakeview in 2016. An overwhelming number of these crimes could have been prevented by removing car keys and locking vehicles.

While you are asleep or enjoying quality time with your loved ones, prowlers are lurking in your neighborhoods searching for unlocked vehicles, intent on stealing your money, credit cards, firearms, computers, and anything of value.

Support our crime fighting efforts in protecting your neighborhoods. Be responsible gun owners and store firearms and other valuables in a safe place.

Remember crime has no address.
