- **b**. 6/19/2020 New Orleans Advocate Doug MacCash reported the Krewe of Nyx hacking allegations lead to internal NOPD investigation. NOPD did not name the employee under investigation, per department policy. Julie Lea's husband, NOPD technology director Chris Lea, retired from the force in 2014 and then returned as a civilian employee. "The employee has been reassigned and his access to all city networks has been suspended pending the outcome of the investigation," said the statement from the NOPD.
- c. 5/13/2020 Reid Raymond reference checked Chris Lea and he mentioned that NOPD has "48 LPR on light poles and 48 on our vehicles."
